Coconut leaves	Upeo	['upɛw] Upeo is made up of 2 words: u 'coconut' and peo 'frond or wing' Say the u like oo in 'hood' Say the e like in 'net' Say the o like w The stress is on the first syllable, say it like this: úpew
Child	Werem	[wɛʾɾɛm] Say the e like in 'net', Say the r like an Italian saying Roma with a little tap of the tongue at the top of the mouth Say the word emphasising the second syllable: werém
Coconuts	U	[u] Say the u like the oo in 'hood'
Dad	Bab	[beb] Say the a like ar in 'hard'
Coconut water	Uni	['uni] Say the i like ee in 'need' The stress is on the first syllable, say it like this: únee
Mum	Ama	[A'me] Say the first a like u in 'hut', Say the second a like ar in 'hard' Say the word emphasising the second syllable: umá [se'bid]
Coconut cream	sabid	[se'bid] Say the a like ar in 'hard' Say the i like ee in 'need'
Stars	Wer	[wɛr] Say the e like in 'net' Say the r like an Italian saying Roma
Coconut water in the shell	Upis	['upɪs] Upis is made up from 2 words: u 'coconut' and pis 'young coconut' Say the i like ee as in 'need' The stress is on the first syllable, say it like this: úpis
